WOW! INCREDIBLE! AMAZING! Our kick off to the church wide emphasis of Worth It has started the new year and decade off with a bang! We have seen a LifeGroup record set and maybe an FBC record average! We saw 324 people here for LG in January. That means we had 120 families/single adults who are going through Financial Peace University on Sunday morning, Sunday, Wednesday, or Thursday nights. Our Goal was 100 families/single adults, so we have blown past that goal! After receiving the anonymous financial snapshots from just 60 families, we discovered almost \$2.5 million of debt. We are excited to see what the Lord is going to do in the next few weeks, months and even years as people find freedom from debt. We've already heard from people: I paid off a credit card, I paid off my car, I paid off this loan. That's so exciting to hear - people being set free to be able to control the resources that God has given them and being able to become generous with those resources! We will continue this journey this coming Sunday with week 4 of Financial Peace University and week 5 of our Worth It message series, and this week's message is entitled You are Worth It! I hope you will join us at 10:30 a.m. for worship. We've seen the third highest worship attendance in the history of Petal FBC and we are excited to see what February holds as we walk thru Worth It together! I promise you it will be worth it!

Also, during this series we are sharing over the next couple of weeks what we are calling worth it moments - connected to last week's message of They Are Worth It! These will feature some ways that you can plug-in, connect, serve and even go here and to the ends of the earth. One of the ways that we will know people are getting it is by the number of people who start investing their lives into those things that are worth it! I hope you'll be here to see how, but let me share with you just a few. You can sign up to be a part of a team going to Haiti



- New Sign and & New Exterior & Interior Signage











